Terri's pastel paintings have gained national and international recognition. She was awarded the title "Eminent Pastelist" by the International Association of Pastel Societies in 2012. She is a Master Pastelist with the Pastel Society of America and "Distinguished Pastelist" status with the Pastel Society of the West Coast, and the Pastel Society of New Mexico. Terri's work has been featured in many art publications including Fine Art Connoisseur, American Art Collector, American Artist, Plein Air Magazine, French art publication Pratique des Arts, The Artists Magazine, and "coffee table books", Art Journey America, Best in Pastel 2010 & Plein Air New Mexico. Her work has been featured on the cover of Pastel Journal.
